

# Camp Kiwanis

Comprising over 66 acres along the Cass River, Camp Kiwanis is a historic, rustic and unique camping facility close to the Tri-Cities. It provides year round camping opportunities to youth groups throughout our area.

Kids of all ages and backgrounds, both veteran campers and first timers, enjoy spending time at the camp. The camp features a natural setting and campers can experience life among the trees, flowers and animals native to this part of Michigan.

The Camp has three cabins and several tent camping areas for campers to choose from. All cabins have electricity. One has a fuel oil furnace and two are heated with wood. Two also have fireplaces, and water is available for all campers.

Located just two miles west of Frankenmuth and ten miles southeast of Saginaw, Camp Kiwanis is close and easily accessible. The camp has appealed to campers young and old for over 80 years, and many groups come back year after year to renew their appreciation of nature by spending a few quiet hours discovering the joys of Camp Kiwanis.

## Rustic Camp

### Affordable, Fun and Educational

#### Sinawik Cabin

- **\$70/2 night** reservation, 22 beds.  
Fuel oil furnace, electric stove, refrigerator and fireplace.

#### Wanigas Cabin

- **\$60/2** night reservation, 26 beds.
- Wood heating stove, wood cook stove, refrigerator and fireplace.

#### Little Hawk Cabin

- **\$50/2** night reservation, 12 beds.
- Wood heating stove, wood cook stove, refrigerator.

#### Old Smokey Nature/Interpretive Center

- **\$20** for 6-hour block ( AM or PM ) with cabin reservation.
- **\$35** for 6-hour block ( AM or PM ) without cabin reservation.
- **\$100/week** ( M-F day camp ).

#### Parade Ground ( with pavilion).

- **\$10/day** if rented with cabin or campsite reservation.
- **\$20/day** for youth groups w/o cabin or campsite reservation.
- **\$30/day** for non-youth groups w/o cabin/campsite reservation.

#### Campsites

- **Outpost, Arrowhead and Wilderness:**  
**\$15/day; \$25/weekend**
- **Hawthorne:**  
**\$20/day; \$45/weekend** (or per day if rented with Parade Ground).

#### Reservation Procedures

1. Scout unit or youth group phones Camp Ranger

2. Ranger confirms requested date is available & fills out a pre-Numbered camp permit.
3. The scout unit or youth group mails the necessary fees to the Camp Ranger @ **Camp Kiwanis 8655 Curtis Rd. Frankenmuth, MI 48734.**
4. The Camp Ranger mails the camp permit form (marked Paid ) back to the scout unit or youth group as confirmation Of reservation.
